This petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case No.COMI/41/2016 titled as “*Lakhvir Kaur Vs. Kuldeep Singh and others*” in which the petitioner has been summoned under Sections 323 and 506 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and the CW-2 who is examined by respondent was not cited in the complaint. Even the respondent/complainant is not resident of the same address which was given by her.

I have heard learned counsel for appearing on behalf of the petitioner and have gone through the case file.

After perusing the record and analyzing the submissions, the competent Court has expressed that simple injuries has been inflicted to the

complainant/respondent and there is prima facie case made out against the petitioner.

At this stage, beyond the prima facie satisfaction of the Court, Competent Court nothing else is to be seen.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.
