RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for granting regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 18 dated 17.3.2016 under Sections 326-A/354-C IPC and Section 3/4 of Children Act and later on added Section 120-B and charges qua petitioner was framed only under Section 326 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, Police District, Batala.

As per the allegations in the FIR, petitioner was driving the motorcycle and one Saajan Massiah was the pillion rider who threw the acid on the girl. After arranging the vehicle he got admitted his sister at Dera Baba Nanak Dev Hospital for treatment.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that main allegations are not framed against the petitioner and his co-accused namely Santokh Singh @ Sukha and Thomas Masih were granted bail by this Court on 10.11.2016 (Annexure P-3) and 28.9.2016 (Annexure P-4) respectively. It is further submitted that out of 22 witnesses 9 witnesses have been examined.

In view of the above and considering the fact that trial would take long time to its own conclusion, petitioner be released on regular bail subject to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Gurdaspur.

Disposed of accordingly.
