Notice of motion to the official respondents.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Sharma, Asstt. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

After hearing arguments at length for some time and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-4) within the framework of law.

Meanwhile, in case any instance of threat is brought to the notice of the Police by the petitioners they will act into it expeditiously in accordance with law.

In the light of specific averments made by learned counsel for the petitioners that there is imminent threat to the life of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents, therefore, the petitioners are ordered to be sent to Protection Home, Sector 19, Chandigarh.

Keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioners that certain persons from their respective families have gathered outside the Court, let Station House Officer, Sector 3, Chandigarh be directed to ensure safe passage of the petitioners from the Court premises to the Protection Home, Sector 19, Chandigarh where they will be lodged as per rules.
