The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.36 dated 15.2.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 468, 469, 120-B IPC at Police Station Kapurthala City, District Kapurthala.

Heard.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined investigation but the recovery of divorce deed and Aadhar card is to be effected from him. The Aadhar card is a document which is available in

Government record and can be obtained from there.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the divorce deed is already with the husband of petitioner and finds mention in the complaint.

Keeping in view the above fact and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 14.3.2017 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against her so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
