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**RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.48 dated 14.04.2001 registered under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga.

The FIR was registered against the petitioner and his son Nachhatar Singh. At one point of time, both were declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 30.01.2002. According to the petitioner, there was an amicable settlement between the parties, but somehow, that was not taken cognizance of by the police. The son of the petitioner namely Nachhatar Singh filed CRM-M No.41896 of 2015 in which he was directed to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court was directed to release him on interim bail subject to its satisfaction vide order dated

10.12.2015.

As a consequence of aforesaid order, Nachhatar Singh surrendered before the trial Court and faced the trial. During the trial, complainant did not support the prosecution case and Nachhatar Singh was acquitted vide judgment dated 25.02.2016.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has admitted the factum of compromise between the parties and submitted that the complainant has no objection in case petitioner is also directed to surrender before the trial Court and face the trial.

In view of above, it would be just and expedient to direct the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court as he is also an accused of offences under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC. Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court within two weeks. In the event of his surrender, he shall be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Necessary consequences to follow thereafter.
