It is pleaded before this Court that since, both the parties have compromised, therefore, concerned Illaqa Magistrate was directed to record

the statements of the parties. On behalf of the complainant, the statement of his attorney Charanjit Singh Walia S/o Fateh Singh Ahluwalia was recorded. The original notarized General Power Attorney Deed dated 12.05.2014 was seen and returned by the learned Magistrate after keeping on record the photocopy of the same.

Today, learned counsel for respondent No. 2/Complainant has appeared before this Court and confirmed the compromise effected between the parties.

Keeping in view the facts that the matter has been compromised between the parties and entire payment has been made and respondent No. 2/complainant has no objection, the sentence of the petitioner is ordered to be reduced to the period already undergone by her.

In view of the above, the present revision petition stands partly allowed.
