ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No. 88 dated 12.02.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341 read with Sections 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3 (Colly)) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR, although five accused are duly named therein. He was arraigned as an accused later on in the supplementary statement of the complainant. He further contends that the matter has now been compromised.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 15.03.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial

Court for recording their statements with regard to the genuineness of compromise. The report of the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Sirsa dated 20.04.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded and they have entered into compromise without any undue influence or coercion.

The petitioner was not named in the FIR. He was arraigned as an accused much later. He was stated to be juvenile at the time of incident. The matter has now been compromised between the parties, who want to put quietus to the litigation.

In view of the law laid down in "*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 88 dated 12.02.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341 read with Sections 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner only.
