On 15.03.2017, following order was passed by this  
Court:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during Jatt Arakshan from 16.02.2016 to 24.02.2016, the intensity of Arakshan was such in the concerned area that it was not feasible for the petitioner to do physical verification. The report submitted by the committee does not implicate the petitioner in any manner.*

*Notice of motion for 08.05.2017.*

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 21.03.2017 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the*

*conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagmit Singh. However, he submitted that recovery is still to be effected from the petitioner. Departmental proceedings are also pending against the petitioner.

Seeing the contents of the earlier order passed on 15.03.2017, I deem it appropriate to make the same absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so.

Petition stands disposed of.
