This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking 'regular bail' to the petitioners, in case FIR No.572 dated 08.11.2015, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 302, 449 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Dadri, District Bhiwani (now District Charkhi Dadri).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been in custody since 09.11.2015 and the material witnesses, i.e. the complainant, as also a person stated to be an eye witness, i.e. Kuldeep, brother of the deceased, have both been examined.

On a specific query put to learned State counsel, he on instructions from the police official who is present in Court to assist him, submits that out of 20 witnesses, 06 have been examined, including the aforesaid two witnesses.

Keeping in view the period of custody of the petitioners as under trials, as also the fact that the trial is not likely to conclude early, I consider it

appropriate to admit the petitioners to bail.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. The petitioners shall be admitted to bail upon their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bhiwani.
