This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking 'regular bail' to the petitioner, in case FIR No.6 dated 19.01.2017, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 395 IPC, registered at Police Station, Khizrabad, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner draws attention to the fact that the complainant in the FIR, i.e. Jamnapuri Chela Sompuri, has sworn an affidavit on 27.02.2017, to the effect that the petitioner was not involved in the incident in which the complainant and his companion were robbed. A copy of the FIR, including its 'vernacular version', have been annexed as Annexure P-3 with the petition.

On a specific query put to learned State counsel, he on instructions from ASI Ranbir, submits that there is no other criminal case seen to be registered against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail.

Consequently, this petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri.
