FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 17.04.2017 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Sirajdeep Singh, Supreet Singh, Gurkirat Singh, Pahuldeep Singh Ghuman, Ekambir Singh Gill, Manvir Singh Gill, Janit Chadha as well as of complainant Shehbaj Singh Dhillon it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature and which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of

law laid down in *Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543* and *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052*, FIR No.715 dated 10.11.2016 under Sections 323,341,506,149 IPC, Police Station, Civil Lines, Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
