Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.28/2017 dated 21.02.2017 registered under Sections 323/326-B/341/506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali, the petitioner was arrested on 22.02.2017 and is in jail since then. Admittedly, the challan has been filed.

Learned counsel for the State pursuant to the last order dated March 21, 2017, makes a statement upon instructions from the investigating officer, that accordingly statements have been recorded and it is the fact that the complainant's daughter has been compensated by the petitioner's family members by remitting her expenses for the burn injuries caused to her.

After seeing the photographs of the girl, this Court found that the girl had received burn injuries on her face and hand. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner's family members would extend

further help to the victim as may be required.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner is directed to cooperate with the investigating agency and he shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence or influence the prosecution witnesses.
