Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 15.03.2017, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court on 17.03.2017 and has been admitted to interim bail by the trial Court. Petitioner was granted interim bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar on 19.07.2014.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar submits that the report of Chemical Examiner has been received in the trial Court. It is made clear that the interim bail granted to the petitioner was only in consonance with the order dated 19.07.2014, whereby interim bail was granted to the petitioner during the period in which FSL report was awaited. This order will not create any impediment in way of the trial

Court in passing of appropriate order after receipt of report of
Chemical Examiner in accordance with law.
