This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for transfer of the complaint No.07 dated 03.02.2016 registered under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 in which trial is pending at the Court of Addl.Civil Judge (Senior Division)-JMIC, Meham to Gurgaon.

Learned counsel contends that the summoning order (Annexure P-1) has been issued on the ground that the cheque in question was never issued in favour of the complainant. The order of summoning is incomplete and does not reflect the cheque number. He further contends that the life and liberty of the petitioner is threatened at the hands of the complainant.

A perusal of the record, reveals that except the bald allegations, there is no evidence to suggest that the order passed suffers from any perversity or illegality. For the convenience of the petitioner, the jurisdiction which does not have a sanctity of law cannot be created in favour of the

petitioner without there being any substantial ground.

No such ground has come up in the present petition.

Dismissed.
