Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No. 656, dated 21.10.2016, under Section 364-A I.P.C., registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Rajesh Kumar submitted that after due investigation, the police has prepared a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and the same is likely to be filed in the Court very soon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the parties have amicably resolved their differences by way of amicable resolution of the dispute and no issue is pending between them as on date.

Without embarking upon merits of the case, let all the parties appear before the Investigating Officer on 20.05.2017. The parties would be at liberty to make their respective statements before the Investigating Officer. The Investigating Officer would be at liberty to satisfy himself with regard to the genuineness of the compromise in question and if he is satisfied, he may move appropriate application/ report before the competent Court in accordance with law.
