Vide this common order CRM-M Nos.8753, 8773, 15063 and 15585 of 2017 are being decided as these petitions involve similar controversy.

After arguing for some time, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioner(s) namely Nitin Dhawan and Gurpreet Suman would surrender before the trial Court and would seek concession of regular bail in accordance with law.

In view of above, CRM-M Nos.15063 and 15585 of 2017 are disposed of with liberty to the petitioners namely Nitin Dhawan and Gurpeet Suman to appear and surrender before the trial Court and in the event of their filing application for the grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law preferably within a period of one week.
