Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of necessary directions to the respondent Nos.1 to 5 in the context of protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner from being invaded at the hands of private respondents.

Petitioner alleged that he is owner in possession of some immovable property and the private respondents are hell bent to take forcible possession of the same. Petitioner is more than 80 years of age and feels reasonable apprehension of violation of his civil rights at the hands of the private respondents.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has also moved a representation before respondent No.4 and the same is statedly pending.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. P.P. Chahar, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage, as no order prejudicial to the interest of respondents is being passed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, respondent No.4 is directed to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner and also the nature of litigation. He shall be at liberty to devise his own ways and means to ascertain the truth. In case some cognizable offence is found to have been committed by the private respondents, the concerned Station House Officer of the police station can be directed to act in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
