This petition has been filed under Section 407 of the Code of Criminal Procedure praying for transfer of Criminal Complaint No. 19 instituted on 21.03.2016 titled as Anika and another vs. Amit Puri, pending before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The instant petition has been preferred by the husband alleging that he had an apprehension that he would be harmed at Sri Muktsar Sahib at the behest of the family members of the respondents. During the pendency of this petition, the parties were referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court which has been successful. Settlement agreement dated 23.10.2017 has also been placed on record. As per the terms of the settlement, after the first motion of the petition, filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, the respondent-party is to withdraw the petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. pending before the JMJC, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

At this stage, Mr. Vaibhav Narang, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and filed his *Vakalatnama*. He also submits that the parties have arrived at a settlement during the mediation proceedings.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties, this petition, filed for transfer of the proceedings pending before the JMIC, Sri Muktsar Sahib, is rendered to be infructuous and disposed of as such. However, while disposing of this petition, liberty is granted to the petitioner to have the petition revived in case the terms of the compromise are not adhered to.
