TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

The petitioners are stated to be working as labourers in a liquor factory in District Patiala and being run by Tarun Kumar Modi son of Sudershan Kumar Modi/respondent No.4.

Counsel submits that respondent No.4 is indulging in activities of misbranding etc. and with which the petitioners do not wish to associate. It is further submitted that under threat the petitioners are being forced to continue their labour work in the liquor factory. Petitioners apprehend a threat to their life and liberty.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition as also the submissions raised by the counsel, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala confined to their grievance as regards threat to their life and liberty.

It is further directed that in the eventuality of any representation being preferred by the petitioners limited to the extent of seeking protection

same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and which are warranted in accordance with law.
