The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.183 dated 1.10.2016 under sections 408, 419, 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 477-A, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Dakha, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

In a nutshell allegation against the accused party including the present petitioner is of having mortgaged the land of an N.R.I namely Surjit Singh by way of impersonation and thereafter on the strength of forged and false documents having obtained an agricultural credit limit of Rs.61,80,000/-.

In so far as the present petitioner is concerned, the matter is stated to be still under investigation and the challan has not been presented.

Under such circumstances, this Court would not be inclined to accept the prayer for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
