Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in consequence of the orders of interim bail dated 22.03.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on bail, which fact could not be controverted by learned State counsel Mr. KDS Sidhu, Addl.
