On 16.03.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are the accused in cross-version which was registered after 7 days of the occurrence and 5 days of registration of the FIR. Offence under Section 326 IPC was added vide rapat No.21 dated 27.01.2016. At one point of time, cross-vesion was enquired into by the higher officers and a cancellation of the same was recommended. However, the same was not accepted and further investigation was ordered.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join

investigation on 23.03.2017 and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that pursuant to the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh. Learned counsel further stated that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of above, interim order dated 16.03.2017 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
