The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 429, dated 19.05.2016, under Sections 307, 427, 379-B IPC, under Section 13(B) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, under Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act and under Section 11 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although offence under Section 307 IPC has been mentioned in the FIR but it is a case of no injury. The allegations in the FIR, inter alia, refer to the use of firearm but it has not been specified, who had fired in the air. He further states that the petitioner is in custody for over 10 months since the date of his arrest on 17.10.2016.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Rajinder Kumar states that charges have been framed and 3 out of 34 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

No injury is stated to have been caused in the incident. The petitioner is in custody for over 10 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Jabbar @ Baru is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
