The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.576 dated 22.11.2013 under Sections 454/341/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sector-17, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that incident is the outcome of a dispute between the landlord and tenant, which has now been resolved.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 16.03.2017, had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqua Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the veracity of compromise. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh, has sent his report dated 11.04.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of

the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.576 dated 22.11.2013 under Sections 454/341/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sector-17, Chandigarh and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
