Counsel for the petitioners and complainant are ad idem that dispute between the parties has been settled by way of compromise reduced into writing on 15.05.2017 and attested copies of compromise deed, affidavit of Harmandeep Sharma and Meetu are taken on record in CRM-M No.10738 of 2017, fixed for today.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of. The petitioners are directed to join investigation within a period of 10 days and on their appearance before the Investigating Officer, they shall be released on bail subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) they shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) they shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.

However, they shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of compromise.
