Petitioner-Sudesh has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.166 dated 27.09.2016, registered under Sections 302, 201, 498-A, 120-B and 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Line Paar, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been in custody since 30.09.2016. It is further contended that the husband of the complainant had already been released on bail. In fact the statement of the complainant has been recorded in which she has turned hostile.

Counsel for the State has opposed the present bail petition.

Heard.

In view of the fact that the statement of the complainant has

been recorded and husband of the complainant has already been released on bail, this Court feels it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner because no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody furthermore as the trial of the case is likely to take some time.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/learned trial Court concerned.

Petition stands disposed of.
