The present petition has been filed by the petitioners for the issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the petitioners' life and liberty which according to them is under threat at the hands of the private respondents on account of the marriage between the petitioners without the consent of the private respondents.

At the time of hearing of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners, who are present in Court stated that the threat perception which has been expressed in the petition was only if the petitioners were to go and live at Amritsar but since they both have decided to live in Chandigarh, at present no such threat perception is there to their life and liberty.

That being so, he prays that at this stage, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
