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In the petition filed by the appellants under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act for grant of compensation on account of death of Pavittar Singh in a road side vehicular accident, the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Ropar had awarded an amount of Rs.4,13,000/- as compensation.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company states that he has instructions to agree to enhancement of the compensation amount by Rs.3,25,000/-.

Learned counsel for the appellants states that her clients are ready and willing to receive the amount as offered by the learned counsel for the Insurance Company.

In view of the above, the Insurance Company shall pay an amount of Rs.3,25,000/- over and above the awarded amount but within a period of one month. The said amount shall be inclusive of an amount of Rs.50,000/- to be paid to Baljinder Kaur claimant, mother of the deceased, for loss of love and affection.

The appeal is, accordingly, disposed of.
