Petitioner-Tarsem Singh @ Soma Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.126 dated 23.10.2016, registered at Police Station Laddowal, Ludhiana, under Sections 307 and 326 (b) of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been got registered by complainant-Ramandeep Kaur against Harvinder Singh. The present petitioner has not been named in the FIR. He has been implicated on the basis of supplementary statement. As per the allegations, there was a matrimonial dispute between Ramandeep Kaur and her husband-Harvinder Singh, who poured acid on her. Later on, a supplementary statement was made attributing the present petitioner that main accused-Harvinder Singh came on his motor-cycle, when he caused the occurrence.

The petitioner has been in custody since 19.01.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the facts that there is no attribution to the present petitioner in the FIR nor he was present at the place of occurrence; the only allegation against him is that the main accused came on his motor-cycle to the house and that the trial of the case will take a long time, I find merit in the present petition and the same is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject

to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
