Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

The petitioners assert that they are major and as there is no legal impediment, they have got married. They have already moved a representation dated 01.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) before respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, for protecting their lives and liberty. As per Aadhaar Card of petitioner No.1 – Amandeep Kaur (Annexure P-1) her year of birth is 1992, thus, she is major.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to take an appropriate action on the representation dated 01.03.2017 (Annexure P-5).

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and going into the question of validity or otherwise of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to consider the representation dated 01.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) and if some substance is found therein, necessary steps, in accordance with law, be taken thereon.
