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**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.181 dated 06.10.2015, under Sections 452, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 458 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an outcome of dispute over a house property between relatives and with the intervention of respectables, the matter has now been compromised.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 18.03.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court.

The report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar, dated 01.04.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in

pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of dispute over a house property between relatives and with the intervention of respectables, the matter has now been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.181 dated 06.10.2015, under Sections 452, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 458 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
