By filing the present petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a criminal case bearing No.COMI/0000147/2013, RBT 88/14 dated 13.06.2014 titled as 'Rashpal Singh Vs. Jagir Singh and another' pending before learned trial Court.

Heard.

Vide order dated 06.01.2017, the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 21.01.2017 and on his doing so, it was ordered that he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the releasing Court. The petitioner was directed to surrender his passport and also directed not to leave the country

without the written permission of this Court as reflected in the order dated 09.09.2016. The petitioner instead of complying with the order, has moved an application CRM No.2102-2017 to go abroad. Moreover, vide order dated 02.02.2017, it was also clarified that the petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court within a week from passing of said order. As the petitioner has failed to comply with orders dated 06.01.2017 and 02.02.2017, no case for pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.
