The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.171 dated 05.12.2012 registered under Section 307 IPC at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar City, in view of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Pursuant to order dated 01.05.2017 learned counsel for the petitioner-husband has tendered FDR in the sum of ₹2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs) in the name his wife Ranjit Kaur.

Petitioner-Malkiat Singh and complainant-Ranjit Kaur, who are present before the Court, make statement that they are now living together and hence prayed that in order to live in peace and harmony FIR be quashed.

In my opinion, since the petitioner-husband and the complainant-wife both are stated to be residing together and has made the

statement in this regard before this Court, there is no point in continuing with the FIR in question. The continuance thereof would spoil the relations of the parties who are husband and wife. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-9107 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) FIR No.171 dated 05.12.2012 registered under Section 307 IPC at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar City, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings, qua the petitioner.
- (iii) The FDR in the sum of ₹2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs) in the name his wife Ranjit Kaur is handed over to her.
