This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking protection of life and property of the petitioner from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 10, who are out and out to harm him and also to damage his property with the money power. No action is being taken by the respondent Nos.3 and 4 on the complaints dated 02.03.2017 and 08.03.2017 (Annexures P-2 and P-4) given by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representations dated 02.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) moved to the SHO (Rural) Jalandhar and dated 08.03.2017 (Annexure P-4), moved to the SSP, Jalandhar, by the petitioner, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.3-SSP, (Rural) Jalandhar is directed to look into the said representations and pass appropriate order within two months, as per law, after receiving the certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
