Petition has been called twice since morning but none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that the police has visited the address of petitioners to enquire the matter but found that none is living there. In the absence of any address of the petitioners, no headway could be made.

As none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners to answer the submissions raised by learned State counsel, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to ensure that life and liberty of petitioners are not put to any harm or threat at the hands of the private respondents or at their behest.

However, it is made clear that nothing contained in this order shall be interpreted as giving protection to the petitioners against any action in civil, criminal or other proceedings instituted to be initiated/pending against them.
