This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No.81 dated 02.07.2015, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.
