This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.0216 dated 12.11.2016 under sections 306, 506, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Kotwali Patiala.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR has been registered on the statement of Rakesh Kumar on the allegations that his brother Vikas Garg has committed suicide on 11.11.2016 on account of having harboured a suspicion that his wife Upasana Thakur was in an illicit relation with the present petitioner.

Petitioner was arrested on 16.1.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has been presented. Charges are yet to be framed. Trial, as such, would take time to conclude.

Counsel for the petitioner would argue that against the backdrop of the allegations, it would be a debatable issue as regards offence of abetment to suicide being made out.

Co-accused Upasana Thakur i.e. wife of the deceased has already been granted benefit of bail.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.

Petition disposed of.
