Prayer is for bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.125 dated 06.08.2014 under Sections 363/366-A IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

It was noted that the alleged victim in this case had not been recovered. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) was directed to look into the matter by this Court on 07.07.2017 and file the necessary report in this respect.

An affidavit dated 01.08.2017 of Sh. Surjit Singh, Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

As per the said affidavit, the victim in this case has been recovered on 21.07.2017. Her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C was recorded on the same day. Copy of the same is attached as Annexure R-1/T with affidavit dated 01.08.2017. The victim stated that the present petitioner is the sister-in-law (*Nanand*) of her aunt (*Masi*), Gurpreet Kaur. The

petitioner is stated to have taken the victim forcibly to Chandigarh and forced her into wrong acts. The victim was thereafter left with one lady at Chandigarh and the said lady left her with one Anil Kumar and now she is married with son of Anil Kumar. The victim prayed for legal action to be taken against the petitioner. At this stage, keeping in view the facts and circumstances, I do not find any ground to grant the concession of bail pending trial to the petitioner at this stage.

Petition is accordingly dismissed at this stage.
