Reply by way of affidavit of Manjit Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar, filed in Court today, is ordered to be taken on record.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3-State to protect their lives and liberty which was apprehended to be under threat on account of petitioners having got married against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, who are the parents of petitioner No.1.

On 17.04.2017, this Court had directed the State to place on record the statements got recorded by the petitioners in pursuance of which the afore-referred affidavit has been filed, a perusal of which shows that the statements of the petitioners and respondent No.4 were got recorded by Davinder Singh, ASI, Police Station 'C' Division, Amritsar City, as per which the petitioners are living together happily as husband and wife and do not have any threat from the private respondents. Respondent No.4 has also stated that neither he nor his family members has any objection to the marriage solemnized by the petitioners.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners, the above facts remain uncontroverted.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
