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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.399 dated 6.10.2016 under sections 379-B/411 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, A Division, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Amit Sharma, who stated himself to be serving as Area Manager in a Research Medicine company. Allegations are that on the intervening night of 4/5.10.2016 when he was going along with his employee in a rickshaw, they were accosted by four unidentified youth. One of the assailants was stated to be holding a Poker/Sua and under the threat of the same one mobile phone along with SIM card, two A.T.M Cards, Driving License, R.C of motorcycle and an amount of Rs.22,500/- cash were snatched.

The present petitioner was arrested on 19.10.2016 by way of production warrant as he was involved in another FIR.

As per prosecution version, recovery of one A.T.M card and one identity card of the complainant has been effected from the petitioner

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has already been presented. Charges are yet to be framed. Trial, as such, would take time to conclude.

It has gone uncontroverted that Kuldeep Singh @ Baba and Ramandeep Singh have been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Petition disposed of.
