Pursuant to the order dated 13.01.2017, though no process fee is seen to have been deposited as per the report of the Registry, learned State counsel has produced in Court today affidavits of the petitioners and respondent No.5, as also an affidavit of the mother of petitioner No.1, namely Surjit Kaur, stating to the effect that the said respondent and she have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners to each other.

The affidavits of the petitioners are also to the effect that they no longer apprehend any threat from respondents No.4 to 12.

Consequently, without commenting upon the validity of the marriage, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, though with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to otherwise ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners continue to be protected, within the four corners of law.
