Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since, pursuant to the order impugned in this petition, i.e. the order of the first revisional Court directing the trial Court to summon 3 persons out of the 4 sought to be summoned, had already been complied with by the trial Court vide its order dated 14.10.2016, i.e. even before this petition first came up for hearing on 17.10.2016, he seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to challenge the order of the trial Court.

On a specific query, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, as a matter of fact, the petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court and have been admitted to bail by that Court.

Keeping in view the fact that 6 months have gone by since the order has been passed by the learned trial Court, and even on merits I do not see any infirmity in the order of the learned first revisional Court, as has been impugned before this Court, this petition is dismissed.

However, nothing stated herein above would be taken to be any

comment on the merits of the case for or against the petitioners.
