Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.147 dated 25.10.2016 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 308 and 325 IPC added later on registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Gurmail Singh in relation to an alleged occurrence that took place on the intervening night of 23/24th of October, 2016.

Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, he is stated to have inflicted three danda blows on the person of complainant on the right elbow, left eye and also on the head.

Petitioner was arrested on 27.11.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete and even challan has been presented.

It has gone uncontroverted that even the complainant/injured Gurmail Singh has already been examined before the trial Court.

Co-accused Gurjant Singh @ Janta Singh has already been granted regular bail by this Court.

In view of the above and length of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
