Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.123 dated 16.07.2015, registered under Sections 364, 307, 397, 398, 341, 323/34 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Labh Singh, submits that in the present case not only has the entire evidence been led before the trial Court, even final arguments have been heard and therefore, at the fag end of the trial regular bail be not granted.

There is no representation on behalf of the petiitoner to controvert the above fact.

In view of the above, at the fag end of the trial, where even the final arguments have been heard by the trial Court, I do not consider the present case to be fit one for the grant of regular bail.
