Deputy Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City on behalf of respondents No.

The petitioner in the petition is seeking protection of life and
liberty and direction to restrain respondent Nos. 4 and 5, who are trying to
dispossess her from her vegetable shop situated at railway crossing, Partap
Bazar, Amritsar.
