TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.424 dated 26.09.2016, under Sections 395/341/379 B of IPC, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Didar Singh. Allegations are that a Canter vehicle which was transporting goods belonging to Blue Dart Courier Company was intercepted while proceeding from Samalkha to Ludhiana by occupants of one Wagon-R car and had been taken away after tying down the driver as also the cleaner of the vehicle.

As per the prosecution, present petitioner has been implicated on the basis of his own disclosure statement made in a different FIR in which he is an accused.

The petitioner has shown to be arrested in the FIR on 14.10.2016.

It has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Kali Charan @ Kalva had already been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court in the light of the order dated 01.03.2017 in CRM-M-6319 of 2017.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan stands presented and even charges have been framed.

Without making any observations on merits and on the ground of parity, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail. Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat subject to the condition that he is not required in any other criminal proceedings.
