Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.135 dated 04.07.2016 under Sections 379 and 380 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar (Rural)-Annexure-P1 on the basis of compromise Annexure-P2.

In pursuance to the order dated 20.03.2017 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate on 30.03.2017 to get recorded their statements. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has also sent its report vide covering letter having Endorsement No.42 dated 15.04.2017 which has been duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide Endorsement No.3275-R dated 17.04.2017.

According to the report, the Judicial Magistrate is satisfied that the parties have made an amicable settlement and have recorded their statements in the Court without any pressure, threat, coercion and out of their free will. It has also been reported that only Kuljit Singh (petitioner) and one unknown person were arrayed as accused in the instant F.I.R. and none of the accused has been declared proclaimed offender.

Considering the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class dated 15.04.2017 and the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, F.I.R. No.135 dated 04.07.2016 under Sections 379 and 380 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar (Rural) is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
