Petitioner-Jasbir Singh alias Minta has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.33 dated 11.02.2017, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Division No.1, District Police Commissionerate, District Ludhiana, under Sections 489-B and 489-C of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR has been registered on the basis of secret information against accused namely Charanjit Singh and Ramdas.

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Both the accused were arrested at the time of raid and as stated, fake currency notes of ₹18,000/- have been recovered from them. The present petitioner has been named in the disclosure statement of the co-accused. The allegation against the petitioner is that he supplied the fake currency notes to the co-accused.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that custodial interrogation of the present petitioner is required in this case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
