Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.49 dated 07.03.2014, under Sections 15/16/27-A/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kalianwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Even as per case of prosecution, the recovery of 400 Kgs. of Poppy Husk was effected, not from the present petitioner but from co-accused Jagtar Singh and Sukhdev Singh. Petitioner is sought to be implicated on the disclosure statement of afore noticed two co-accused and as per which, the present petitioner had acted as a mediator in a deal and through which, the contraband had been purchased by Jagtar Singh and Sukhdev Singh from Jagraj Singh.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 14.03.2014.

He is not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Trial would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.

Petition disposed of.
