Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.171, dated 22.08.2015, registered under Sections 22/ 61/ 85 of NDPS Act, at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been appearing before the trial Court on each and every date, unless specifically exempted, but due to inadvertently having noted a wrong date could not appear before the trial Court on 17.02.2017. He submits that as per the interim order of this Court dated 21.03.2017, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been admitted to ad interim bail to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel admits the fact that the petitioner was absent only on one date before the trial Court; that as per the interim orders of this Court he has surrendered before the trial Court and on such surrender has been admitted to ad interim bail.

CRM-M-9500 of 2017 :2:

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 21.03.2017 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions as prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.
